## CAMP MASTER PLAN

In August 2019, The Y Camp celebrated our 100 Year Camp Anniversary! It was during this celebration that we unveiled our master plan that includes:

- Open Air Pavilion
- Improved Bathroom Facilities
- Benson Lodge Improvements
- Boardwalk & Improved Trail System

This plan will provide **life changing camp experiences** for generations to come.

## COMPLETED IMPROVEMENTS

- New access road off S. Lake Blvd
- New Swimming & Fishing Docks
- Cabin improvements interior & exterior such as roofs, plumbing, electrical & paint

Our Master Plan included a Forest Management Plan which began in the fall of 2019 by cutting older growth Poplar, Jack Pine, Red, and White Pine.

The sale of those trees generated \$22,000 which was used to replant trees, mill logs for use in the open air pavilion and other plantings in the future.
