SUPERIOR DOUGLAS COUNTY FAMILY YMCA BIRTHDAY PARTY RENTAL GUIDELINES

The Superior YMCA Facility does not allow any drug use, including tobacco or alcohol, on the premises. The user group or organization agrees to release and hold harmless the Superior Douglas County Family YMCA from any claims, demands, damages, actions, and causes of action, of every kind or nature which may occur during the group or organization's usage or occupancy. Further, the user group or organization agrees to indemnify the Superior Douglas County Family YMCA for:

• The negligent acts of any agent or representative of the user group or organization.

GUIDELINES TO BE FOLLOWED:

- 1. Parties are limited to 25 swimmers
- 2. Parties are required to designate an individual, 21 years of age or older, who will be responsible for the conduct of the group.
- 3. Party must provide adult supervision in the locker rooms, swimming pool and pool deck area at all times.

IN-WATER SUPERVISION REQUIREMENTS:

<u>Fewer than 25 youth, aged 7 and older:</u> Renting party must provide a minimum 2 supervising adults, with one adult **IN THE WATER** and one remaining on deck. <u>Fewer than 25 youth, aged 6 and younger:</u> Renting party must provide a minimum of one supervising adult who remains on deck AND one adult in the water for every 4 participants age 6 and under. Adults in this 1:4 ratio must remain **IN THE WATER** within arms' reach of youth participants.

<u>More than 25 youth, any ages:</u> In addition to the above guidelines, renting party must provide an additional adult supervising in-water for every 25 swimmers.

- 4. Groups are expected to follow all posted pool/slide rules. (Rules are explained by the lifeguard on duty prior to each swim time)
- 5. Rental groups are responsible for any damages to YMCA equipment, facilities, and/or property caused by the group.
- 6. The Superior YMCA assumes no responsibility for the personal property of individuals or groups utilizing the facility.
- 7. The Y will have tables and chairs for 25 guests set up in the room assigned to your party. Decoration of the room may not begin earlier than the time designated above. You may rearrange the tables & chairs however you see fit.
- 8. Fitness equipment & electronics in Multi-Purpose room are not to be used. These items need to stay stored and left as is. Any damage caused to YMCA property by anyone in your party will result in the party being held financially liable.
- 9. Parties may bring in food. Roasters, crock pots or other electric devices are allowed. Food may also be delivered from area restaurants.
- 10. The open flames of birthday candles must be extinguished immediately after being lit. No other open flames are allowed.
- 11. Upon completion of the party at 5:00 pm, the party is asked to wipe down tables and chairs and leave room as which you found it. Trash may be placed next to the receptacles in that room.
